Day 1

Depart for Spain's Andalusia Region

Day 2 • Arrive in Seville

Today you arrive in lively Seville, the heart and pulse of Andalusia. Here your meet and greet will provide you with a welcome package. Your transfer will then proceed to drive you to your elegant hotel by the historic quarter.

Check –in your hotel and rest. This evening enjoy a welcome dinner in one of Seville's established gourmet restaurants.

Day 3 • Seville — Day at the Real Club de Golf de Seville

After breakfast, your transfer will drive you to the Real Club Golf of Seville, where you will play one of Europe's best courses, designed by Jose Maria Olazabal. When finished, you may want to have lunch and drinks in their Club. Spend the rest of the afternoon relaxing or wandering through the historic and narrow lively streets of this vivacious city, capital of Andalusia.

This evening, you will have the option of joining a group panoramic tour of beautiful Seville by night that will take you through the magnificent Royal Gardens and the Spanish Pavilion, built especially for the International Fair in 1920. This will be followed by a flamenco performance.

Day 4 • Day in Seville

Your private guide will greet you at your hotel lobby after breakfast. Then you'll head off on a walking tour seeing some of Spain's wonderful historic monuments and sites located in Sevilla's historic quarter. The Moors Your tour will include a stop at La Giralda, . This is the enormous cathedral is the burial place for Christopher Columbus. There will also be time to visit to the Patio de los Naranjos, a unique Moorish garden lined with orange trees over 600 years old.

Your tour with end with the Alcazar, a majestic Palace originally built by the Moorish dynasty in the 8th century and later expanded in the 15th century by King Peter the Cruel. It's presently used by the Spanish Monarchy as a residence when visiting Seville, and during special government functions.

Although your escorted tour ends, there's no reason you can't continue to explore on your own. Surely, you'll want to visit the Roman Governor Pontius Pilatus former home, the Flamenco Museum or the Church that holds the Virgin of Macarena, Seville's saint patron. If you prefer, you can shop until uyou drop at one of the many awesome shops scattered throughout Seville.

Day 5 • Montecastillo Golf and Spa Resort (Jerez)

After, enjoying your breakfast, you'll travel to the beautiful surroundings of Jerez de la Frontera, home of sherry. Montecastillo Golf and Spa Resort will be your home for the next 4 nights.

You'll have the opportunity to play the course at the Montecastillo, former site of the Volvo Masters. Spend your afternoon in their wellness sauna and spa. Evening is on your own to do as you please.

Day 6 • Dehesa Montenmedio Golf and Country Club (Cadiz)

This morning play this beautiful Andalucian Golf Club, where you will find yourself surrounded by carefully tailored fairways, which require accuracy and precision to keep the ball in play. It's considered one of Europe's finest courses by both professionals and amateurs.

You will then be treated to a visit to lovely Jerez de la Frontera, sherry capital of the world. Here you'll tour one of their family owned and prestigious local bodegas. Learn about their wine aging process and sherry distillery methods, and then you will enjoy a professionally led wine and sherry tasting.

In the afternoon, you might want to visit the lovely port city of Cadiz.

Day 7 • Valderrama

After breakfast, get ready to play in one of the most prestigious golf clubs in the world. Valderrama is considered by many as the top golf course in all of Europe. After this rewarding experience, you might want to enjoy a late lunch, before returning to your resort.

This evening you may choose to dine at the Marina Club and enjoy the wonderful sunsets found in Costa del Sol.

Day 8 • Alcaidesa Links (Sotogrande)

This morning you will travel to the area of Sotogrande, to play yet another outstanding course at the Alcaidesa Links with unbelievable panoramic views of Gibraltar. After lunch at the 19th hole, enjoy a leisurely drive back to Montecastillo for a restful evening and maybe some bragging about your great day on the course.

Day 9 • Seville International Airport

Today you can drive to Seville's international airport, and return your rental car or you may choose to be driven for your connecting flight back home.
